FC has recommended a budget of Rs.20.84 crores from MNRE Grants. (Rs.10 crores under Capital and Rs.10.84 crores under Revenue).

\*\* The balance amount of Rs.0.38 crores (Rs.21.217- Rs. 20.84) and any additional requirements will be requested to the Ministry in the RE stage.

The GC after discussion approved recommendations of FC and the total budget of Rs. 30.84 Crores (Rs. 20.84 Cr. from GIA and Rs. 10. Cr. from internal earnings) for the year 2021-22.

### Agenda item No. 47.05 To 47.10 (New proposals)

The following new proposals are presented by Member Secretary for consideration of the GC;

- 1. **Item No. 47.05:** Establishment of REWS Meteorological Mast & Measurement System for Turbine Test Station at Kayathar and Dhanushkodi with a budgetary estimation of Rs. 4.22 Crores.
- 2. **Item No. 47.06:** Establishment of National Wind Tunnel for Wind Sensor Calibration to cater to the Wind Industry needs for complying to the requirements of IEC Standards with a budgetary estimation of Rs. 15-16 Crores..

- 3. **Item No. 47.07:** Establishment of Infrastructure for efficient storage and retrieval system for RE Resource Data at NIWE, Chennai with a budgetary estimation of Rs. 3.32 Crores.
- 4. **Item No. 47.08:** Dismantling of LiDAR based offshore sub structure at Gulf of Khambhat, off Gujarat Coast with a budgetary estimation of Rs. 2.4 Crores.
- 5. **Item No. 47.09:** Participation of NIWE in Technology Collaboration Programme (TCP) of IEA Wind and to join under IEA Tasks with an annual budgetary estimation of Rs. 35 lakhs.
- 6. **Item No. 47.10:** Long term wind data measurement and Forecasting with a budgetary estimation of Rs. 1.739 Crores.

The GC approved the proposal at Sr. no. 4 & 5 above (agenda item no. 47.08 & 47.09) and directed to carry out the tasks from the already allocated budget of NIWE.

Further, the committee after detailed deliberations, accorded in-principle approval for the following two proposals and directed NIWE to carry out only the required preliminary activities.

- 1. Item no. 47.06: Establishment of National Wind Tunnel for Wind Sensor Calibration to cater to the Wind Industry needs for complying to the requirements of IEC Standards.
- 2. Item No. 47.10: Long term wind data measurement and Forecasting

However the committee noted that at present there is no budgetary provision for carrying out these preliminary activities.
