After detailed discussion **GC approved the proposal** and advised to extend the contract of hiring manpower under various activities on direct contract mode for further period of one more year (maximum 2 years) subjected to the requirement and evaluation.

The expenditure on this account will be met under CFA grants.

Member Secretary explained the proposals placed in the 30th meeting of the R&D Council of NIWE held on 6th March 2024.

- External Proposal on "Development of Floating LiDAR Offshore Wind Measurement System A
 Demonstrative Project" with duration of 36 months and an estimated budget of INR 1116
 Lakhs starting from the FY 2024-25 till completion of the project duration to be met from CFA
 Funds.
- In house proposal on "Application of Turbulence normalization for Power Performance and Validation of Method" with duration of 1.5 years and an estimated budget of INR 10 Lakhs starting from the FY 2024-25 till completion of the project duration to be met from CFA Funds.
- In house pproposal on "Field investigations on acoustic noise measurements of existing wind turbines of various capacities in different terrain conditions (Flat, Complex, Semi-Complex) with duration of 18 months and an estimated budget of INR 25 lakhs starting from the FY 2024-25 till completion of the project duration to be met from CFA Funds.

For the above three projects GC accorded approval totalling to Rs.11.51Cr. Out of which sum of rupees Rs.3.50 Cr is required (Rs.1.40Cr under capital and Rs.2.10cr under revenue) for indigenous

development of floating buoy project to transferred to IIT bombay/ NIOT, Chennai during the current financial year 2024-25. The balance fund will be sought during the financial year 2025-26. For remaining in-house two projects (Turbulence normalization and acoustic noise measurement) funds for the tune of Rs.25Lakhs and Rs.10Lakhs will be utilized during the current financial year 2024-25.

After discussion GC approved all the three proposals.
